BREEDING OF DOGS ACT 1973 BREEDING AND SALE OF DOGS (WELFARE) ACT 1999

NOTE: only dog breeding establishments that produce 5 or more litters of puppies per year from 5 or more separate bitches (at one litter per bitch) will need to apply for this licence. It is unlawful for a bitch to give birth more than once a year.
