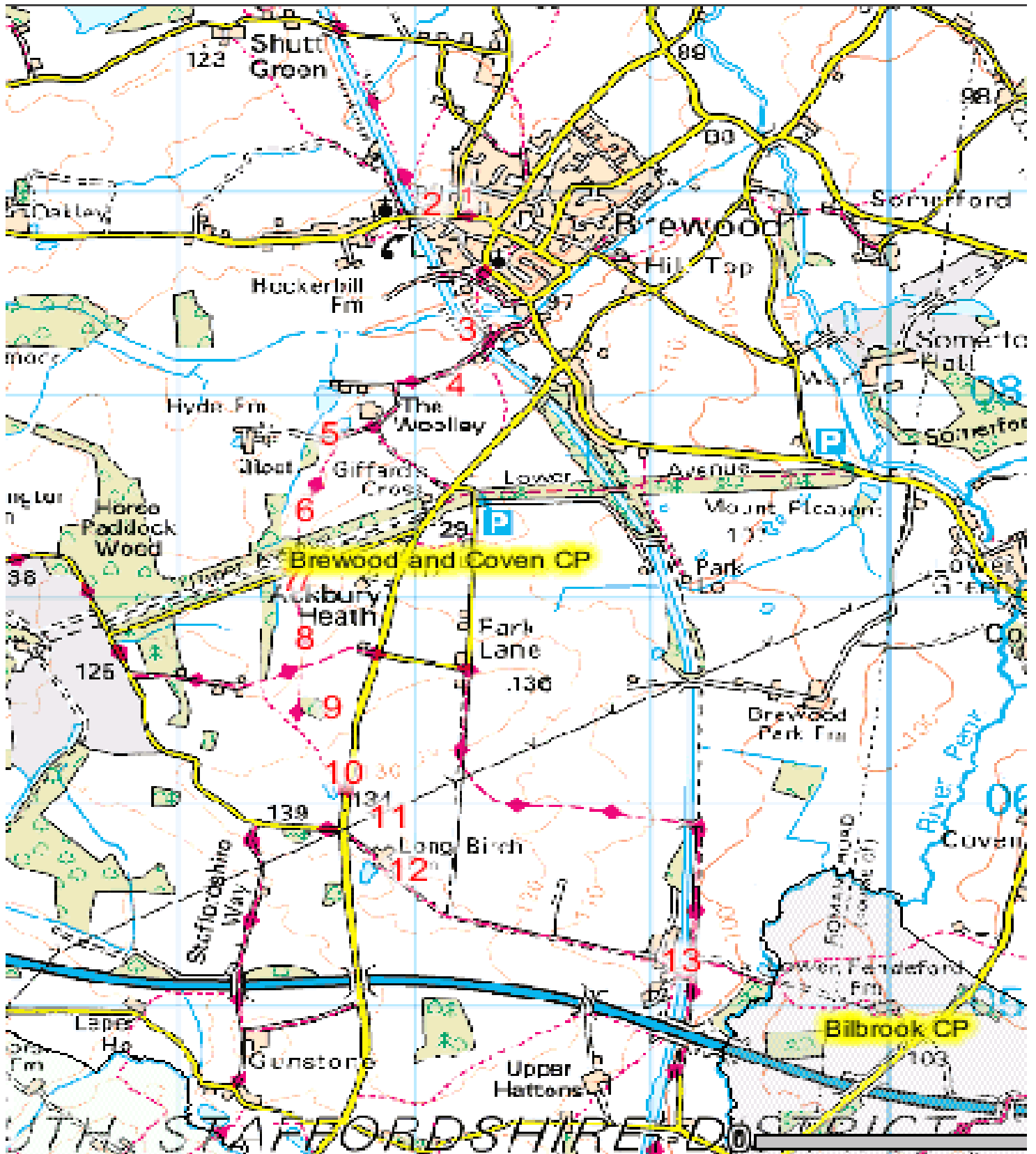


## **A Circular Walk from Brewood**

This walk is around 6 miles long and should take around two to two and a half hours. The walk is on mainly paths and the canal and is a little muddy in places so strong shoes are recommended. The walk is on a road for a short distance so face oncoming traffic and wear visible clothing.

- 1) Parking is available on Bargate Street in the Village.
- 2) Start the walk opposite the Bridge Inn, enter canal on towpath and keep going straight on.
- 3) Exit at the second bridge you come to, Bridge 12, towpath can be exited from step to your left or pass under the bridge where there is a ramp. After leaving the towpath cross the bridge and head down path.
- 4) You will come to junction in the path, turn left heading for Woolley Farm. Follow this path and pass Wolley Farm on your right.
- 5) After the farm look out for Staffs Way markers on your left. Enter the field through the gate and cross the field, there are markers along the field.
- 6) Go through the kissing gate and stile and carry straight on, go over the tracks, look to your right to see Chillington Hall.
- 7) Cross stile and the road, through a kissing gate and into another field.
- 8) Cross stile and go straight over track
- 9) Cross stile in the corner of the field and go straight on through small copse and then follow the edge of the field.
- 10) Cross the next stile and turn right at the road.
- 11) Come to a private road on the left with a Bridleway marker, go through small gate on the right and head down path.
- 12) Pass through farm, bearing right follow path and go through gate.
- 13) At the next farm bear right and head over canal bridge, after the bridge turn left and follow path until you come to an entry onto the canal. Turn right onto the canal and had back to the start along the canal.
