Title of document: Core Strategy Development Plan Document (DPD)

Subject Matter: The Core Strategy (DPD) sets out the strategic planning policy for South Staffordshire, including a spatial vision and objectives. It also sets out a development strategy which identifies the level of development expected to take place within South Staffordshire up until 2027 and includes a number of Core Policies and Development Policies which will help to achieve the vision. All subsequent LDF documents produced will build upon the Core Strategy.
