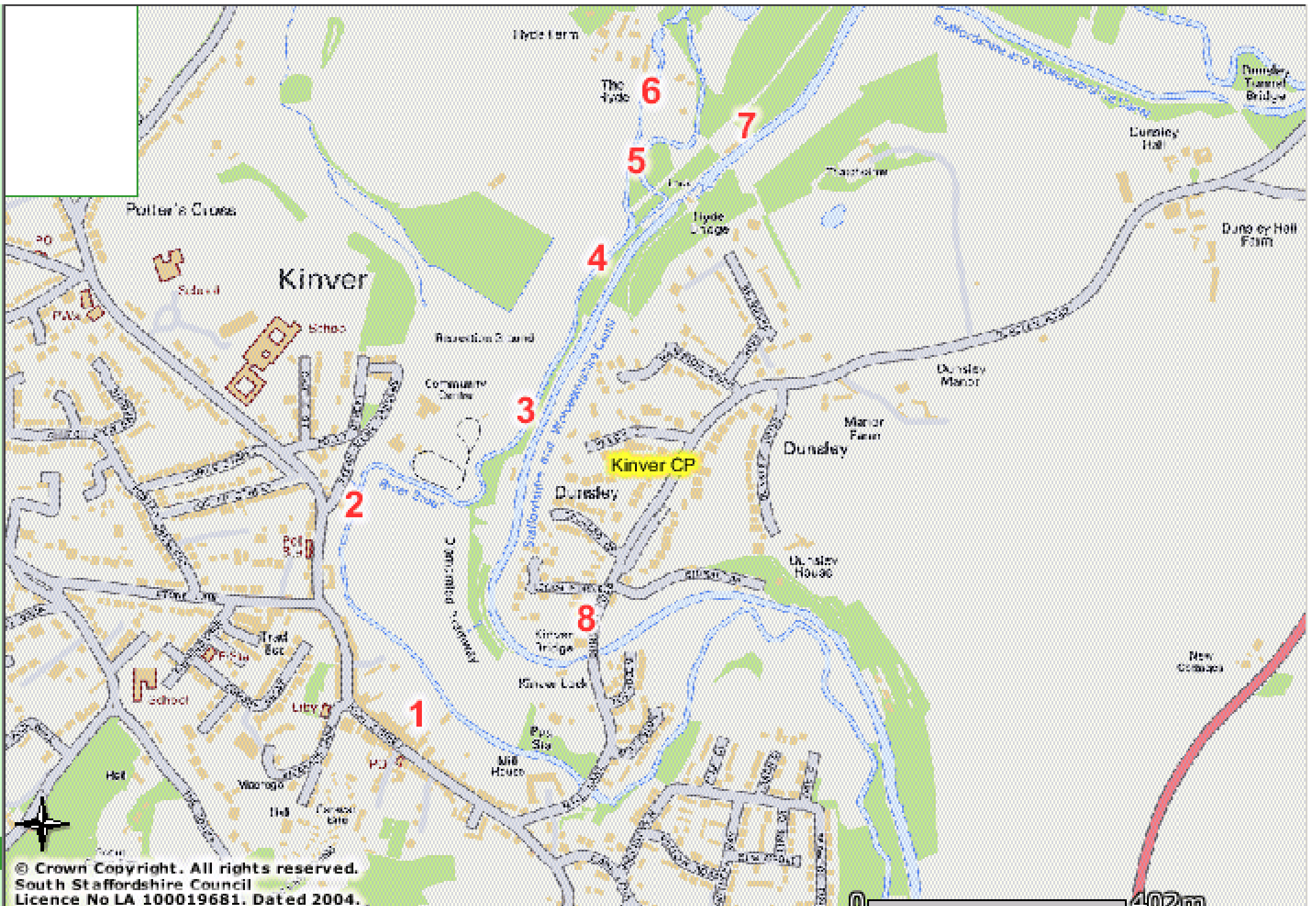


A short circular walk around Kinver

This walk is pleasant short walk that takes in the best of this picturesque South Staffordshire Village. The walk should take around 45 mins to 1 hour and is on mainly flat well walked paths. There are several kissing gates to negotiate and the path is narrow in places. The path also runs alongside fields with horses in.

Although a brisk walk is great for your health, make sure you get your head up to enjoy the splendid scenery around the route, especially on the canal.

- 1) Free parking is available on the High Street Car park opposite the Parish Council Offices. WC facilities are available for 20p at this Car Park.
Exit the car park onto the road and turn right.
- 2) Follow the footpath until you come to Sterrymere (Road sign Legion Drive). Head towards the Community Centre.
- 3) Look to the bottom right and corner of the car park next to the Playground for the Public Footpath Way Marker. Follow the path round the playing fields.
- 4) Go through kissing gates, through fields with horses.
- 5) You will come to some stable take the path to the right, through kissing gate and down path with wall to either side.
- 6) You will come out into a clearing, look to the right for a bridge, cross bridge and follow path until you come to the canal.
- 7) At Staffordshire & Worcestershire Canal turn right and keep going until you come to the Vine Pub and the road.
- 8) At Vine Pub turn right onto footpath and follow the footpath all the way through the village back to the starting point.
