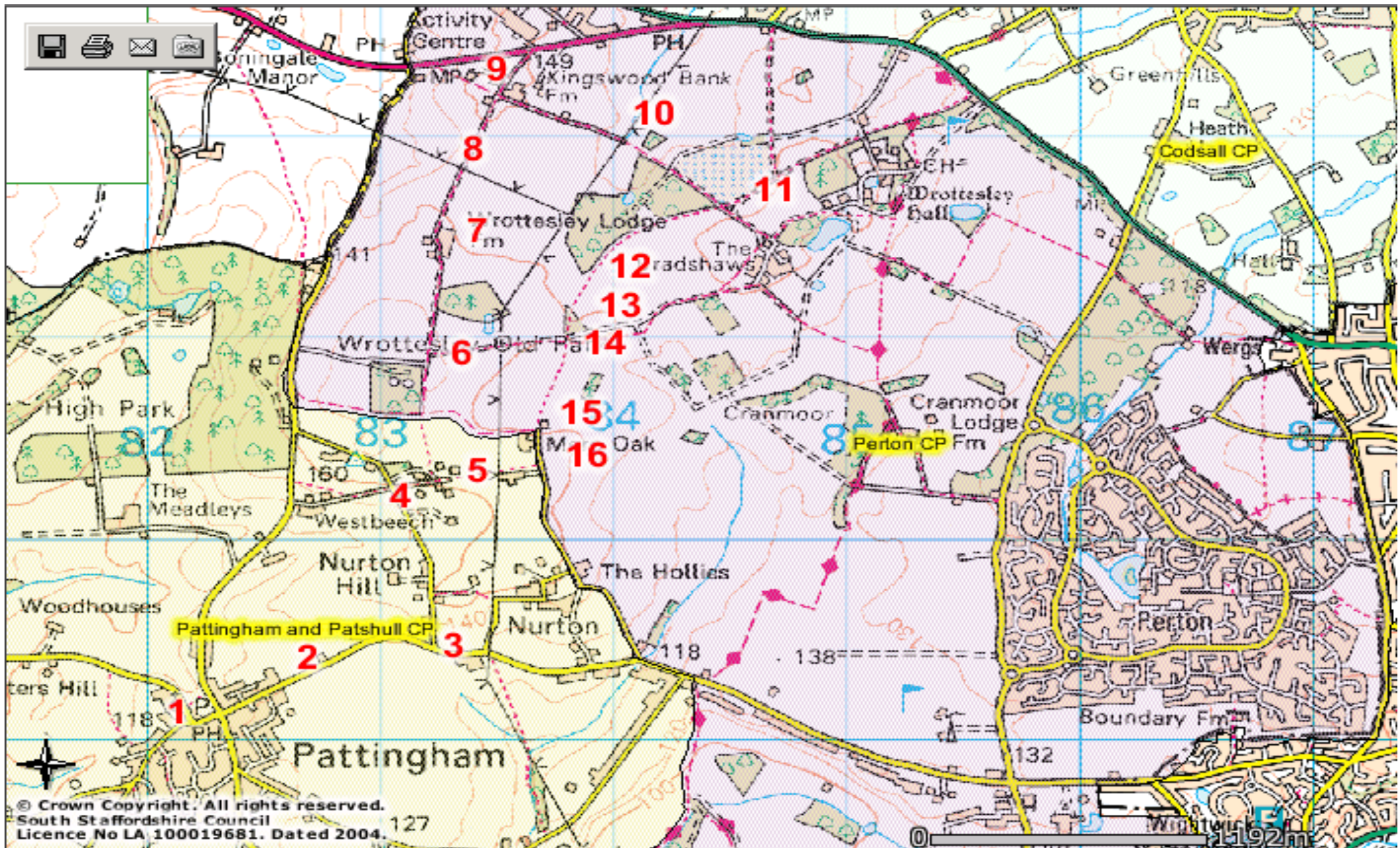


Pattingham Walk

This walk is around 6 miles and should take between two and two and a half hours. There are some great views of the countryside from the walk. However a couple of things to be aware of are; at the beginning and end of the walk you will be walking on the so make sure you face oncoming traffic and are wearing visible clothing. There a few stiles to cross and the ground is uneven and muddy in places.

- 1) Parking is available outside the Church opposite the Pigot Arms Public house. With the Church behind you and the pub in front head left along the footpath. Keep going straight signposted Tettenhall and Wolverhampton.
- 2) The footpath ends just outside the village, you will be walking on the road make sure you are on the right hand side, facing the oncoming traffic.
- 3) Turn left into Norton Hill Rd
- 4) At the top of the hill, just after Beech Acre House you will see a Public Footpath post, turn right onto the footpath.
- 5) Near the top of the track look out for a footpath to the left, opposite House Merrion, if you have come to a gate you have gone to far. Follow the alley way until you come to a field and then follow edge of field.
- 6) At the edge of the wood carry straight on.
- 7) Follow the Rd through the farm.
- 8) As you leave the farm look to the left and you will see the Wrekin and the new shiny structure at RAF Cosford. Follow the steady hill up to Kingswood Bank Farm.
- 9) Come to houses at the top and look out for Bridleway signs and turn right onto Bridleway.
- 10) Go through gate and field to second gate.
- 11) At Crossroads turn right and follow path into the wood, path forks in several places always take left fork to stay near the edge of the wood.
- 12) You will come to a clearing, keep walking and look out for a small, narrow bridge on the left, cross the bridge and turn right on the edge of the field.
- 13) You will come to a copse, and take the small path heading into the copse, this path is quite narrow and a little overgrown.
- 14) Come out of the copse to a track, go straight over into field on the left. Keep to right edge of field.
- 15) Come to a style and go straight over.
- 16) Watch out for Waymarker sign and path on the right and join this path. Keep going over fences until you come to point 4 and trace your steps back to Pattingham.
