Dear Sir/Madam

Further to the Kinver Neighbourhood Plan, namely Policy KNO2 which outlines:

Housing growth will be supported within the Kinver, Lawnswood, New Wood and Stourton boundaries and infill development of gaps in exiting built frontages.

I am [REDACTED] very concerned that the identified 'gap' between Lawnswood Farm on Lawnswood may be used to build houses,. However boundary of this so called gap borders onto Local Green Space within the South Staff/West Midlands boundary.

Although this land is not included in the South Staffs Local Plan, my concern is that the owner of this land (a property developer) will use the definition of 'gap' to build houses on the piece of green belt.

I would like South Staffs to consider including the 'Lawnswood Gap' as a proposed green space including defining the land in question (between Hunters Ride and Lawnswood Farm) is not proposed or defined as a 'infill' as it borders green belt already.
