Notification of carriageway reconstruction works on the C0260 Elliotts Lane, Codsall

As part of the Council's ongoing investment into its roads in Staffordshire, Staffordshire County Council has been awarded funding by the Department of Transport, as part of its Levelling Up Fund. Amey Services Ltd working with Staffordshire County Council, will shortly begin carrying out works on the C0260 Elliotts Lane, from Yew Tree Gardens to the roundabout on Watery Lane and at the junction of Bilbrook Road. Works will include the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface, along with other preparation works known as civil works.

From **Monday 20 May 2024**, we'll begin the first phase of the scheme. This will include the replacement to the damage tactile crossings, along with the clearing of vegetation from the footways and removal of the existing carriageway ironworks.

These initial works will be carried out using temporary traffic signals, between the hours of **9.00am – 15.00pm**. The civil works are due to be completed on **Friday 24 May 2024**.

Following on from the civil works, we will begin our carriageway reconstruction works, this will include the re-setting and replacement of carriageway ironworks, the removal of the existing carriageway surface and replacing it with a new surface.

Works will take place from **Tuesday 28 May to Saturday 1 June** between the hours of **7.30am to 19.30pm** and **Sunday 2 June** between the hours of **7.30am to 22.00pm**.

Due to the size and scale of construction machines being used and to ensure the safety of the general public and workforce, sections of the carriageway will at times become impassable and therefore, it will be necessary to close sections of Elliotts Lane, Sandy Lane and Bilbrook Road to through traffic during the surfacing works. The road closures will be in place from **7.30am to 19.30pm (Tuesday 28 May to Saturday 1 June) and Sunday 2 June** between the hours of **7.30am to 22.00pm**. Outside of these times the road will remain open.

From **Monday 3 June to Tuesday 4 June 2024**, we'll begin our final phase of the scheme of works, the replacement of the road markings. For this works, we'll be using temporary traffic signals between the hours of **09.00am to 15.00pm**.

Please see the table on page 3, which provides details about the road closures, temporary traffic signals and working times, along with details about the phases of work.

To allow the carriageway surfacing work to be carried out safely, these works have been scheduled to take place during the school holidays when traffic volumes are lower and to minimise disruption to the local community.

A primary road diversion route will be in place for through traffic during the closures.

Local signed diversion route will be in place during the closures; along with designated personnel at either end of the closure points to offer assistance and assist with access when safe to do so to residential properties and businesses. Please plan ahead and allow extra time for your journeys.

For the number of properties within the work area, access will be maintained when safe to do so, however at times access may not be possible within the areas of work for short periods. This is for both your safety and the safety of the workforce.

Pedestrian access along the length of the works will be maintained throughout.

Emergency services will be given access through the road closures.

Additional signage will be placed at key strategic points, directing members of the public wanting to access the leisure centre during the road closures.

Bus stops along Elliotts Lane will be suspended during the road closures. If you require any further information about this service, please speak to your bus operator.

Unfortunately, with any major highway works, some disturbance is unavoidable, and there may be short delays even on the approaches to the closure points. I must ask that you drive carefully and slowly through any sections of live roadworks for both the workforces and your own safety.

During the road closure period, waste and recycling collections will remain the same, on their normal collection delays.

Please note that all dates are subject to change due to operational requirements and weather conditions.

The works may at times be noisy, and we apologise in advance for any inconvenience or disturbance caused. We'll do our best to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible. We like to thank you for your patience during this works.
